

AND THERE WILL BE NO MORE...

Let's look at the "no mores" in the kingdom of God that is to come:

1. No more separation from God

Rev 21:3 And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "**Now the dwelling of God is with men, and he will live with them. They will be his people, and God himself will be with them and be their God.**"

2. No more night

Rev 21:23 The city does not need the sun or the moon to shine on it, for the glory of God gives it light, and the Lamb is its lamp. 24 The nations will walk by its light, and the kings of the earth will bring their splendor into it. 25 On no day will its gates ever be shut, for **there will be no night there.**

Rev 22:1 Then the angel showed me the river of the water of life, as clear as crystal, flowing from the throne of God and of the Lamb 2 down the middle of the great street of the city. On each side of the river stood the tree of life, bearing twelve crops of fruit, yielding its fruit every month. And the leaves of the tree are for the healing of the nations. 3 No longer will there be any curse. The throne of God and of the Lamb will be in the city, and his servants will serve him. 4 They will see his face, and his name will be on their foreheads. 5 **There will be no more night. They will not need the light of a lamp or the light of the sun, for the Lord God will give them light.** And they will reign for ever and ever.

3. No more sea

Rev 21:1-2 Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and **there was no longer any sea.** I saw the Holy City, the new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride beautifully dressed for her husband.

4. No more corruption

Mat 6:20 **But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moth and rust do not destroy...**

5. No more sin

Mat 6:20 **But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moth and rust do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal.**

Rev 21:26 The glory and honor of the nations will be brought into it. 27 **Nothing impure will ever enter it, nor will anyone who does what is shameful or deceitful**, but only those whose names are written in the Lamb's book of life.

6. **No more curse**

Rev 22:3 **No longer will there be any curse.** The throne of God and of the Lamb will be in the city, and his servants will serve him.

7. **No more bad memories**

Isa 65:17 "Behold, I will create new heavens and a new earth. **The former things will not be remembered, nor will they come to mind.**

8. **No more crying**

Isa 65:17 "Behold, I will create new heavens and a new earth ...The former things will not be remembered, nor will they come to mind. 18 But be glad and rejoice forever in what I will create, for I will create Jerusalem to be a delight and its people a joy. 19 I will rejoice over Jerusalem and take delight in my people; **the sound of weeping and of crying will be heard in it no more.**

Rev 21:4 **He will wipe every tear from their eyes.** There will be **no more ... mourning or crying...**

9. **No more pain**

Rev 21:4 There will be **no more...** pain...

10. **No more sickness**

Rev 22:2 On each side of the river stood the tree of life, bearing twelve crops of fruit, yielding its fruit every month. And **the leaves of the tree are for the healing of the nations.**

11. **No more death**

Rev 21:3 And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Now the dwelling of God is with men, and he will live with them. They will be his people, and God himself will be with them and be their God. 4 He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be **no more death** or mourning or crying or pain, **for the old order of things has passed away.**"

Rev 22:14 “Blessed are those who wash their robes, that they may have the right to **the tree of life** and may go through the gates into the city.

Matt 19:29 And everyone who has left houses or brothers or sisters or father or mother or children or fields for my sake will receive a hundred times as much and **will inherit eternal life.**

Matt 25:46 “Then they will go away to eternal punishment, but **the righteous to eternal life.**”

John 3:14-16 Just as Moses lifted up the snake in the desert, so the Son of Man must be lifted up, that **everyone who believes in him may have eternal life.** For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that **whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.**

John 3:36 **Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life,** but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for God’s wrath remains on him.”

John 4:14 ...whoever drinks the water I give him will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give him will become in him **a spring of water welling up to eternal life.**

John 4:36 Even now the reaper draws his wages, even now **he harvests the crop for eternal life,** so that the sower and the reaper may be glad together.

John 5:21-29 For just as **the Father raises the dead and gives them life,** even so **the Son gives life to whom he is pleased to give it.** ... I tell you the truth, **whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life** and will not be condemned; he has crossed over from death to life. I tell you the truth, **a time is coming and has now come when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God and those who hear will live.** For as the Father has life in himself, so he has granted the Son to have life in himself.... Do not be amazed at this, for **a time is coming when all who are in their graves will hear his voice and come out—those who have done good will rise to live,** and those who have done evil will rise to be condemned.

John 6:27-51 Do not work for food that spoils, but for food that **endures to eternal life,** which the Son of Man will give you. And this is the will of him who sent me, that **I shall lose none of all that he has given me, but raise them up at the last day.** For my Father’s will is that **everyone who looks to the Son and believes in him shall have eternal life,** and I will raise him up at the last day... I tell you the truth, **he who believes has**

everlasting life. I am the bread of life. Your forefathers ate the manna in the desert, yet they died. But here is the bread that comes down from heaven, which **a man may eat and not die.** I am the living bread that came down from heaven. **If anyone eats of this bread, he will live forever...**

John 10:27-28 My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me. **I give them eternal life, and they shall never perish;** no one can snatch them out of my hand.

John 11:25-26 Jesus said to her, **“I am the resurrection and the life. He who believes in me will live, even though he dies; and whoever lives and believes in me will never die...”**

John 17:2 For you granted him authority over all people that **he might give eternal life to all those you have given him.**

Acts 13:48 When the Gentiles heard this, they were glad and honored the word of the Lord; and all who **were appointed for eternal life** believed.

Romans 2:6-7 God “will give to each person according to what he has done.” To those who by persistence in doing good seek glory, honor and immortality, **he will give eternal life.**

Romans 5:21 so that, just as sin reigned in death, so also grace might reign through righteousness **to bring eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.**

Romans 6:22-23 But now that you have been set free from sin and have become slaves to God, the benefit you reap leads to holiness, and **the result is eternal life.** For the wages of sin is death, but **the gift of God is eternal life** in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Gal 6:8 The one who sows to please his sinful nature, from that nature a will reap destruction; the one who sows to please the Spirit, **from the Spirit will reap eternal life.**

1 Tim 1:16 But for that very reason I was shown mercy so that in me, the worst of sinners, Christ Jesus might display his unlimited patience as an example for **those who would believe on him and receive eternal life.**

1 Tim 6:12 Fight the good fight of the faith. **Take hold of the eternal life to which you were called** when you made your good confession in the presence of many witnesses.

Titus 1:2 a faith and knowledge **resting on the hope of eternal life, which God, who does not lie, promised before the beginning of time**

Titus 3:5-7 he saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit, whom he poured out on us generously through Jesus Christ our Savior, so that, having been justified by his grace, **we might become heirs having the hope of eternal life.**

1 John 2:25 And this is what **he promised us—even eternal life.**

1 John 5:11-13 And this is the testimony: **God has given us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. He who has the Son has life;** he who does not have the Son of God does not have life. I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God **so that you may know that you have eternal life.**

Jude 21 Keep yourselves in God's love as you wait for the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ to **bring you to eternal life.**

2 Cor 5:1 Now we know that **if the earthly tent we live in is destroyed, we have a building from God, an eternal house in heaven, not built by human hands.** 2 Meanwhile we groan, **longing to be clothed with our heavenly dwelling,** 3 because when we are clothed, we will not be found naked. 4 For while we are in this tent, we groan and are burdened, because we do not wish to be unclothed but to be clothed with our heavenly dwelling, so that **what is mortal may be swallowed up by life.**

2 Cor 15: 35 But someone may ask, "How are the dead raised? With what kind of body will they come?" 36 How foolish! What you sow does not come to life unless it dies. 37 When you sow, you do not plant the body that will be, but just a seed, perhaps of wheat or of something else. 38 But God gives it a body as he has determined, and to each kind of seed he gives its own body. 39 All flesh is not the same: Men have one kind of flesh, animals have another, birds another and fish another. 40 There are also heavenly bodies and there are earthly bodies; but the splendor of the heavenly bodies is one kind, and the splendor of the earthly bodies is another. 41 The sun has one kind of splendor, the moon another and the stars another; and star differs from star in splendor. 42 So will it be with **the resurrection of the dead. The body that is sown is perishable, it is raised imperishable; 43 it is sown in dishonor, it is raised in glory; it is sown in weakness, it is raised in power; 44 it is sown a natural body, it is raised a spiritual body.** If there is a natural body, there is also a spiritual body. 45 So it is written: "The first man Adam became a living being" a; the last Adam, a life-giving spirit. 46 The spiritual did not come first, but the natural, and after that the spiritual. 47 The first man was of

the dust of the earth, the second man from heaven. 48 As was the earthly man, so are those who are of the earth; and as is the man from heaven, so also are those who are of heaven. 49 And just as we have borne the likeness of the earthly man, so shall we bear the likeness of the man from heaven. 50 I declare to you, brothers, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God, nor does the perishable inherit the imperishable. 51 Listen, I tell you a mystery: **We will not all sleep, but we will all be changed**— 52 in a flash, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, **the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed.** 53 For **the perishable must clothe itself with the imperishable, and the mortal with immortality.** 54 When the perishable has been clothed with the imperishable, and the mortal with immortality, then the saying that is written will come true: **“Death has been swallowed up in victory.”** 55 **“Where, O death, is your victory? Where, O death, is your sting?”** 56 The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law. 57 But thanks be to God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.
