

## **Matthew 13:34-35 (HCSB)**

*<sup>34</sup> Jesus told the crowds all these things in parables, and He would not speak anything to them without a parable, <sup>35</sup> so that what was spoken through the prophet might be fulfilled: I will open My mouth in parables; I will declare things kept secret from the foundation of the world.*



## **John 12:48 (HCSB)**

*The one who rejects Me and doesn't accept My sayings has this as his judge: The word I have spoken will judge him on the last day.*



## **Revelation 20:11-12 (HCSB)**

*<sup>11</sup> Then I saw a great white throne and One seated on it. Earth and heaven fled from His presence, and no place was found for them.*

*<sup>12</sup> I also saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, and books were opened. Another book was opened, which is the book of life, and the dead were judged according to their works by what was written in the books.*



## **Daniel 7:9-10 (HCSB)**

*“As I kept watching, thrones were set in place, and the Ancient of Days took His seat. His clothing was white like snow, and the hair of His head like whitest wool. His throne was flaming fire; its wheels were blazing fire.*

*A river of fire was flowing, coming out from His presence. Thousands upon thousands served Him; ten thousand times ten thousand stood before Him. The court was convened, and the books were opened.*



## **Romans 14:10-12 (HCSB)**

*“For we will all stand before the tribunal of God.*

*<sup>11</sup> For it is written:*

*As I live, says the Lord,  
every knee will bow to Me,  
and every tongue will give praise to God.”*

*<sup>12</sup> So then, each of us will give an account of  
himself to God.*



## **Isaiah 66:18 (NKJV)**

*“For I know their works and their thoughts. It shall be that I will gather all nations and tongues; and they shall come and see My glory.*



## **Matthew 7:21-23 (NKJV)**

*<sup>21</sup> “Not everyone who says to Me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven. <sup>22</sup> Many will say to Me in that day, ‘Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?’ <sup>23</sup> And then I will declare to them, ‘I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness!’*



## **Matthew 25:30 (HCSB)**

*Throw this good-for-nothing slave into the outer darkness. In that place where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.'*



## Titus 1:16 (HCSB)

*They profess to know (ME) **God**, but they deny (Me) **Him** by their works. They are detestable, disobedient, and disqualified for any good work.*



**Luke 6:46 (HCSB)**

*“Why do you call Me ‘Lord, Lord,’ and don’t do the things I say?”*



## **James 2:19 (HCSB)**

*You believe that God is one; you do well. The demons also believe—and they shudder.*



## **James 2:14-20 (HCSB)**

*<sup>14</sup> What good is it, my brothers, if someone says he has faith but does not have works? Can his faith save him?*

*<sup>15</sup> If a brother or sister is without clothes and lacks daily food <sup>16</sup> and one of you says to them, “Go in peace, keep warm, and eat well,” but you don’t give them what the body needs, what good is it? <sup>17</sup> In the same way faith, if it doesn’t have works, is dead by itself.*

*<sup>18</sup> But someone will say, “You have faith, and I have works.” Show me your faith without works, and I will show you faith from my works. <sup>19</sup> You believe that God is one; you do well. The demons also believe—and they shudder.*


*<sup>20</sup> Foolish man! Are you willing to learn that faith without works is useless?*

He will die because of the iniquity he has practiced. <sup>27</sup> But if a wicked person turns from the wickedness he has committed and does what is just and right, he will preserve his life. <sup>28</sup> He will certainly live because he thought it over and turned from all the transgressions he had committed; he will not die.*

19


*You unleash your mouth for evil
