
Who do men say I am?

Feast of Tabernacles


- ☐ John 7:14-15 Not until halfway through the Feast did Jesus go up to the temple courts and begin to teach.

HIS DISCIPLES




Simon Peter

John 6:66-69 From this time many of his disciples turned back and no longer followed him.



Andrew



Philip


John 1:43-45 The next day Jesus decided to leave for Galilee. Finding Philip, he said to him, "Follow me." Philip, like Andrew and Peter, was from the town of Bethsaida. Philip found Nathanael and told him, "We have found the one Moses wrote about in the Law, and about whom the prophets also wrote—Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph."

John 1:46-49 "Nazareth! Can anything good come from there?" Nathanael asked.

"Come and see," said Philip. When Jesus saw Nathanael approaching, he said of him, "Here is a true Israelite, in whom there is nothing false." "How do you know me?" Nathanael asked. But he said to them, "Unless I see the nail marks in his hands and put my finger where the nails were, and put my hand into his side, I will not believe it." A week later his disciples were in the house again, and Thomas was with them. Though the doors

were locked, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you!" Then he said to Thomas, "Put your finger here; see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it into my side. Stop doubting and believe."

Thomas said to him, "My Lord and my God!"


☐ John 1:3 Through him all things were made;

 - □ John 1:16-17 From the fullness of his grace we have all received one blessing after another. For the law was given through Moses; grace and truth came through Jesus Christ.




- 4. AUTHORITY TO MAKE US CHILDREN OF GOD

5. GOD IN FLESH


- ☐ John 1:1 In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

lives and believes in me will never die.


Do you believe this?"


Feeding of 5000

The Triumphal Entry



The Man Born Blind

Luke 2:10-11 But the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid. I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. Today in


the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is Christ the Lord.

Village of Sychar



The thief on the cross



Then he said, "Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom."




Nicodemus

"No one ever spoke the way this man does," the guards declared.


The centurion at the cross



"Shall I crucify your king?" Pilate asked.


John 19:19-22 Pilate had a notice prepared and fastened to the cross. It read: JESUS OF NAZARETH, THE KING OF THE JEWS ...

WAS JESUS JUST A GOOD MAN?





I am trying here to prevent anyone saying the really foolish thing that people often say about Him: "I'm ready to accept Jesus as a great moral teacher, but I don't accept His claim to be God." That is the one thing we must not say. A man who was merely a man and said the sort of things Jesus said would not be a great moral teacher. He would either be a lunatic on a level




with the man who says he is a poached egg - or else he would be the Devil of Hell. You must make your choice. Either this man was, and is, the Son of God: or else a madman or something worse. You can shut Him up for a fool, you can spit at Him and kill Him as a demon; or you can fall at His feet and call Him Lord and God. But let us not come with any patronising nonsense about His being a great human teacher. He has not left that open to us. He did not intend to.

HIS FORE-RUNNER



John 1:6-8 There came a man who was sent from God; his name was John. He came as a witness to testify concerning that light, so that through him all men might believe. He himself was not the light; he came only as a witness to the light.

☐ John 1:15 John testifies concerning him. He cries out, saying, "This was he of whom I said, 'He who comes after me has surpassed me because he was before me."

2. FROM HEAVEN

□ John 3:31 "The one who comes from above is above all; the one who is from the earth belongs to the earth, and speaks as one from the earth. The one who comes from heaven is above all.

3. SPIRIT WITHOUT LIMIT

☐ John 3:34 For the one whom God has sent speaks the words of God, for God gives the Spirit without limit.


4. THE MESSIAH - CHRIST - ANOINTED ONE

□ John 3:26-30 They came to John and said to him, "Rabbi, that man who was with you on the other side of the Jordan—the one you testified about—well, he is baptizing, and everyone is going to him."

To this John replied, "A man can receive only what is given him from heaven. You yourselves can testify that I said, 'I am not the Christ but am sent ahead of him.' The bride belongs to the bridegroom. The friend who attends the bridegroom waits and listens for him, and is full of joy when he hears the bridegroom's voice. That joy is mine, and it is now complete. He must become greater; I must become less.

5. THE SON OF GOD



I have seen and I testify that this is the Son of God."



6. GOD

"Who are you? Give us an answer to take back to those who sent us. What do you say about yourself?"

John replied in the words of Isaiah the prophet, "I am the voice of one calling in the desert, 'Make straight the way for the Lord."



☐ Isaiah 40:3 A voice of one calling: "In the desert prepare the way for the LORD; make straight in the wilderness a highway for our God.

7. ATONEMENT FOR SIN

John 1:26-29 "I baptize with water," John replied, "but among you stands one you do not know. He is the one who comes after me, the thongs of whose sandals I am not worthy to untie." ... The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, "Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!

8. ONLY WAY OF SALVATION

☐ John 3:35-36 The Father loves the Son and has placed everything in his hands. Whoever believes

in the Son has eternal life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for God's wrath remains on him."
