### 1 SAMUEL 3:1 (NIV)

The boy Samuel ministered before the LORD under Eli. In those days the word of the LORD was rare; there were not many visions.



### 1 SAMUEL 3:2-5 (NIV)

- One night Eli, whose eyes were becoming so weak that he could barely see, was lying down in his usual place.
- The lamp of God had not yet gone out, and Samuel was lying down in the temple of the LORD, where the ark of God was.
- Then the LORD called Samuel. Samuel answered, "Here I am."
- And he ran to Eli and said, "Here I am; you called me." But Eli said, "I did not call; go back and lie down." So he went and lay down.

### 1 SAMUEL 3:6-7 (NIV)

<sup>6</sup>Again the LORD called, "Samuel!" And Samuel got up and went to Eli and said, "Here I am; you called me." "My son," Eli said, "I did not call; go back and lie down."

<sup>7</sup>Now Samuel <u>did not yet know the LORD:</u> The word of the LORD had not yet been revealed to him.

### 1 SAMUEL 3:8 (NIV)

8The LORD called Samuel a third time, and Samuel got up and went to Eli and said, "Here I am; you called me." Then Eli realized that the LORD was calling the boy.

### 1 SAMUEL 3:9 (NIV)


<sup>9</sup>So Eli told Samuel, "Go and lie down, and <u>if He calls you</u>, say, 'Speak, LORD, for your servant is listening." So Samuel went and lay down in his place.

### 1 SAMUEL 3:10 (NIV)

<sup>10</sup>The LORD came and stood there, calling as at the other times, "Samuel! Samuel! Then Samuel said, "Speak, for your servant is listening."

### 1 SAMUEL 3:11 (NIV)

"See, I am about to do something in Israel that will make the ears of everyone who hears of it tingle."



### 1 SAMUEL 3:11 (THE MESSAGE)

<sup>11</sup>God said to Samuel, "Listen carefully. I'm getting ready to do something in Israel that is going to shake everyone up and get their attention."

### PHILIPPIANS 4:6 (THE MESSAGE)

### **JOSHUA 19:9 (THE MESSAGE)**

- \*The inheritance of Simeon came out of the share of Judah, because Judah's portion turned out to be more than they needed. That's how the people of Simeon came to get their lot from within Judah's portion.
- \*Judah's name means, "Praise!"

## IN THE BOOK OF PSALMS, DAVID MAKES A CHOICE TO REJOICE.

- In the last five chapters of the book of Psalms, each chapter begins and ends with the phrase, "Praise Ye The Lord!"
- In between each chapter, David tells all about what God has done and all about what God can do.

- \*Psalms 146:1 (KJV) Praise ye the LORD. Praise the LORD, 0 my soul.
- Psalms 146:10 (KJV) The LORD shall reign for ever, even thy God, O Zion, unto all generations. <u>Praise ye</u> the LORD.

- \*Psalms 147:1 (KJV) Praise ye the LORD: for it is good to sing praises unto our God; for it is pleasant; and praise is comely.
- Psalms 147:20 (KJV) He hath not dealt so with any nation: and as for his judgments, they have not known them. Praise ye the LORD.

- Psalms 148:1 (KJV) Praise ye the LORD. Praise ye the LORD from the heavens: praise him in the heights.
- Psalms 148:14 (KJV) He also exalteth the horn of his people, the praise of all his saints; even of the children of Israel, a people near unto him. Praise ye the LORD.

- Psalms 149:1 (KJV) Praise ye the LORD. Sing unto the LORD a new song, and his praise in the congregation of saints.
- Psalms 149:9 (KJV) To execute upon them the judgment written: this honour have all his saints. <u>Praise ye the LORD.</u>

### PSALM 150:1-6 (KJV)

<sup>1</sup>Praise ye the LORD. Praise God in his sanctuary: praise him in the firmament of his power.

<sup>2</sup>Praise him for his mighty acts: praise him according to his excellent greatness.

<sup>3</sup>Praise him with the sound of the trumpet: praise him with the psaltery and harp.

<sup>4</sup>Praise him with the timbrel and dance: praise him with stringed instruments and organs.

<sup>5</sup>Praise him upon the loud cymbals: praise him upon the high sounding cymbals.

<sup>6</sup>Let every thing that hath breath praise the LORD. <u>Praise ye the LORD</u>.

### ISAIAH 61:1-3 (MESSAGE)

<sup>1</sup>The Spirit of God, the Master is on Me because God anointed Me. He sent Me to preach good news to the poor, heal the heartbroken, Announce freedom to all captives, pardon all prisoners.

<sup>2</sup>God sent Me to announce the year of His grace - a celebration of God's destruction of our enemies-and to comfort all who mourn,

<sup>3</sup>To care for the needs of all who mourn in Zion, give them bouquets of roses instead of ashes, <u>Messages of joy instead of doom</u>, a praising heart instead of a languid (unenergetic) spirit. Rename them "Oaks of Righteousness" planted by God to display His glory.

# WE CAN MAKE A CHOICE TO REJOICE

### NEHEMIAH 8:10 (NIV)

Nehemiah said, ".... This day is sacred to our Lord. Do not grieve, for the joy of the LORD is your strength."
